

Driving Directions:

From I-5 North or I-5 South

- 1. Take exit for WA-520 toward Bellevue/Kirkland
- 2. Take the Montlake Blvd exit toward University of Washington
- 3. Turn left on Montlake Blvd E
- 4. Turn left onto NE Pacific St
- 5. Turn right onto N.E 15th Ave
- 6. Continue until you reach NE 41st st. Central Plaza parking garage is on the right.

From 405 North or South

- 1. Take WA 520 West towards Seattle.
- 2. Follow steps 2-6 for I-5 N directions above.

From WA 520 West

- Head West on WA 520 towards Seattle.
- Follow steps 2-6 for I-5 N directions above.
